Don't let tuition costs keep your child from enrolling in GRACE. Together, we will find a way to make GRACE an affordable option for your family.

FINANCIAL AID

GRACE works with families to find a way to make a Catholic education accessible to all students—no matter your economic situation. There are a number of ways that tuition can be managed or reduced, including payment plans and multi-child discounts. Additionally, there are many other options to explore, including:

GRACE Tuition Assistance: An established scholarship endowment that supports more than 225 students each year. Families must enroll first and then complete the online TADS application. Deadline: April 15 for first consideration.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program: Qualifying families can receive state aid that covers the full cost of tuition and fees. Available to families who meet residency and eligibility requirements. Deadlines are strict.

Wisconsin Tax Deduction: Wisconsin taxpayers can deduct private school tuition expenses from their taxable income. Maximum deduction per child for K-8 is \$4,000.

SCRIP Tuition Reductions: Families can purchase gift cards for items purchased daily, such as gas, clothing or groceries. Once school requirements are met, a percentage of what is purchased can be discounted off a student's tuition.

School/Parish Assistance: Many Catholic parishes and schools work with GRACE to make additional funds available to assist qualifying families. For further details, contact your school's principal or parish.
