In compliance with the GRACE enrollment process, all Parents/Guardians will be responsible for fulfilling several commitments as part of the investment in your child's educational costs.

General Tuition Requirements

Your tuition payment is composed of the following charges as provided for in the respective schedules and determined by the child's enrollment:

- Tuition
- Enrollment fee
- Activity fee
- Technology fee

Site Participation Requirements

1. Third Source Fundraising (SCRIP) Agreement

Only 34% of the costs needed per student are covered by paid tuition. The remaining 66% of costs are funded through many sources including generous parish investment, an annual appeal, and third source fundraising. To maintain affordable tuition, invest in technology and safety, purchase educational supplies, increase marketing efforts, and provide engaging community building experiences, third source fundraising is via in closing the gap.

I/We commit to supporting third source fundraising by choosing one of the following:

_____ Raise \$50 in SCRIP profits **PER FAMILY** by May 1, 2024 or pay the balance to the school by May 15, 2024. Families can purchase SCRIP at St. Matt's or online via RaiseRight, and the total profit will count towards the requirement.

_____ Our family chooses to **opt out** of purchasing SCRIP, and we **agree to pay \$50** which will be added to our tuition plan.

Once a family has met the SCRIP requirement of \$50 in profit for the school, 50% of any additional profit will be applied toward their FACS-GRACE tuition for 2024-25, or if their child is in 8th grade, will be applied to Notre Dame Academy (NDA) tuition for 2024-25. No refunds will be provided for families not returning to FACS or GRACE.

2. Service Hours Agreement

As part of the FACS community, we invite you to actively engage in the educational experience of our students through volunteering. Involvement in the entire community in the efforts of FACS not only supports the students, teachers, and staff, but also plays a critical role in building relationships which helps our school community thrive.

We strongly recommend a minimum of **10 hours per family** volunteering in ways that support the school with at least 5 of those hours towards the school's annual fundraiser. Volunteer opportunities include but are not limited to work on the annual fundraiser, lunch or recess duty, chaperoning, school events, and assisting teachers with classroom tasks.
